Please join us for the Grand Opening of the town's newest trail!

Clifton Park Town Officials will join with Clifton Park – Halfmoon Public Library Director Alex Gutelius and Shenendehowa Superintendent of Schools Dr. L. Oliver Robinson on Wednesday, Sept. 21 at 11 a.m. to officially open the new Library Trail linking the Moe Road trail system with Clifton Park's town center.

Trail is located between the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Library and the Arongen Elementary School.

We will meet in the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library parking lot at 475 Moe Road, Clifton Park, NY 12065 on Wednesday, Sept. 21 at 11 a.m.



This nearly 1000-foot ADA-compliant trail links the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library to the Arongen Elementary School and Wall Street near the Southern Saratoga YMCA. With this new trail, residents can now walk to or bike from anywhere along the Moe Road trail system to the Exit 9 commercial area. The trail recently had a soft opening and has already seen significant use despite the fact that it has not yet been publicized.

The trail connects Moe Road to Wall Street via a wide, asphalt multi-use path from the edge of the Library sidewalk, across the Stony Creek and a healthy wetlands area visible from a wide boardwalk, and along the edge of Arongen Elementary School, to the side of the YMCA on Wall Street. The trail is along open grassy areas, through a wooded area, and connects the community to various great institutions and businesses while being close to many residential areas.

The new trail truly was a partnership between the town, library and school district. The school district built the part of the trail from Arongen to Wall Street, the town built the section from the library to Arongen and the library donated the property for public right-of-way use.
